

Warren Hills

Rock-type: Granite.

Faces: South-West.

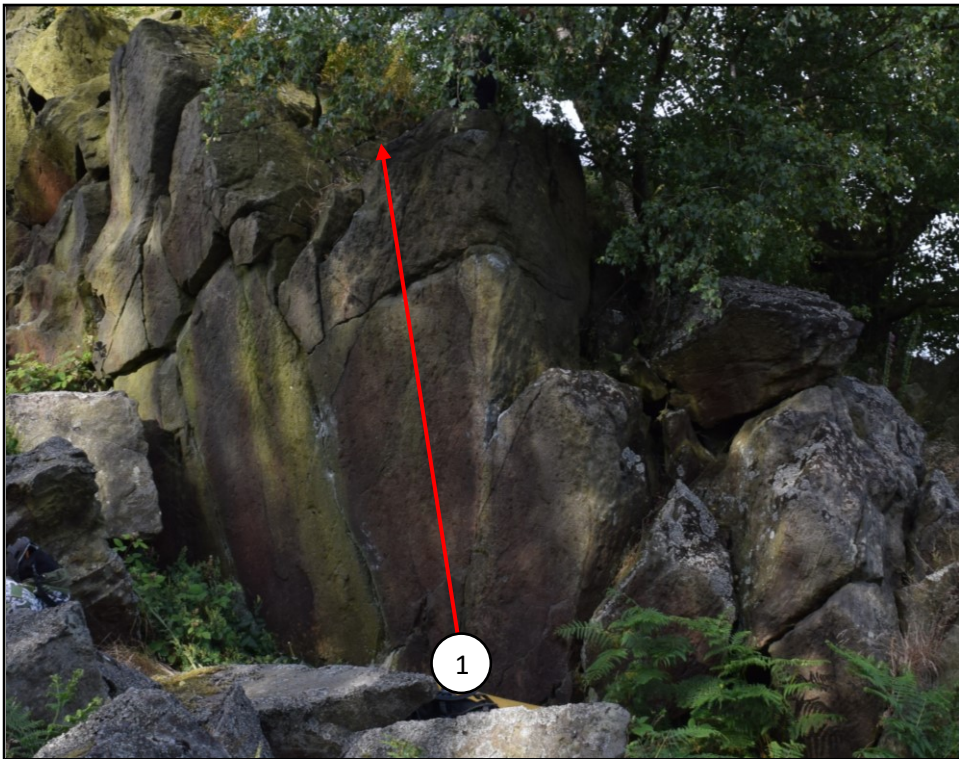
Climbs: 1

Warren Hills was briefly mentioned in the 'Minor Outcrops' section of the old Leicestershire Climbs guidebook. The area has lots of rock but not much climbing.

One tiny quarry gives a boulder problem ([52.72930,-1.31920](#)).

Parking: Warren Hills Road, Coalville LE67 4BR ([52.7265,-1.3161](#))

Approach: Walk north into the reserve and take the first path on the left and follow it until you see the small quarried face on your right ([ViewRanger Map](#)).



1. The Rabbit is a Coward 6A
Sit start the quarried wall.
